UNIFORM SERVICE FEES SCHEDULE

The uniform fees for services provided by the Fire Districts of Manatee County are:

1. PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the reviews of plans, permits, and inspections for:

- Emergency Fire Apparatus Access:
 - Roadways
 - Turnarounds
 - Emergency Access/Fire Lanes
 - Automatic Gates that do not require a building permit
- Water Supply Requirements:
 - Hydrants
 - Minimum Flow Requirements
- Fire Sprinkler/Standpipe Requirements
 - Point of Service
 - Backflow Devices
 - Fire Department Connection (FDC)

2. BUILDING AND DEMOLITION RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the reviews of plans, permits, and inspections for:

- Building:
 - New construction
 - Renovations
 - Remodels
- Demolition
- Tents
- Temporary Use

a. Building/Demolition/Tent/Temporary Use permit submission -	\$65.00
b. Consultation/Pre-construction review/Courtesy review -	\$65.00
c. Each plan re-submittal (<i>incomplete application or previously denied plan</i>)-	\$115.00
d. Work conducted without a permit (<i>in addition to initial review fee</i>) -	\$195.00

Payments for Building and Demolition Related Services shall be paid directly to the Fire District office the property/project is located within prior to approval.

3. FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the reviews of plans, permits, and inspections for:

- Fire Sprinkler Systems:
 - Underground
 - Aboveground
- Other Suppression Systems:
 - Cooking/Hood
 - Fire pump/Standpipe
 - Clean Agent
- Fire Alarm Systems

b. Consultation/Pre-construction review/Courtesy review -	\$65.00
c. Each plan re-submittal (<i>incomplete application or previously denied plan</i>)-	\$115.00
d. Work conducted without a permit (<i>in addition to initial review fee</i>) -	\$345.00
e. Initial system field acceptance test -	No Charge
f. Each system field acceptance re-test - (<i>Must be paid PRIOR to scheduling the re-test</i>)	\$125.00

Payments for Building and Demolition Related Services shall be paid directly to the Fire District office the property/project is located within prior to approval.

4. CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the final inspections of the following in order to receive a Certificate of Occupancy (CO) by Manatee County.

- Compliance with approved plans
- Fire Protection Systems documentation
- Life safety features
- Exit and emergency lighting
- Egress systems
- Fire Extinguishers
- Addressing numbers
- Rapid entry systems

| b. Each re-inspection of a failed initial CO final inspection - | \$125.00 |
| c. Occupancy prior to issuance of a CO (<i>in addition to re-inspection fees</i>) - | \$500.00 |

Payments for Certificate of Occupancy Related Services shall be paid directly to the Fire District office the property/project is located within prior to approval.

5. FIREWORKS AND PYROTECHNICS RELATED SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the plans, permits, inspections, and standby for:

- On-going fireworks/pyrotechnics related permitting
 - Storage
 - Product testing
- Public fireworks displays by a licensed pyrotechnic
 - Indoor
 - Outdoor

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| a. Annual Fireworks/Pyrotechnic Testing and Storage Permit - | \$500.00 |
| b. Each Public Fireworks Display submission -
(<i>Includes a pre-display site inspection, a standby of fire/rescue personnel and equipment during the display for at least 1 hour, and a post-display site inspection</i>) | \$320.00 |
| c. Public Fireworks Display standby (<i>beyond the initial hour</i>) | |
| i. Equipment costs - current F.E.M.A. Schedule of Equipment Rates | |
| ii. Personnel costs - per Fire District employee pay and benefits rates | |

Payments for Fireworks and Pyrotechnics Related Services shall be paid directly to the Fire District office the property/project is located within prior to approval.

6. STANDBY SERVICES

This will include, but not be limited to the provision of Fire District personnel and equipment for:

- Required standbys:
 - Fire watch
 - Incidents
 - Events
 - Requested standbys
- a. Equipment costs - current F.E.M.A. Schedule of Equipment Rates
 - b. Personnel costs - per Fire District employee pay and benefits rates
 - c. Supply costs - the actual replacement costs for any supplies used

The Fire District the property/incident/event is located within shall provide an invoice for services at the conclusion of the standby.


A RESOLUTION OF THE PARRISH FIRE DISTRICT BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, ADOPTING A USER SERVICE FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, the Parrish Fire District pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 191.006(11), F.S. has authority to charge user fees authorized by resolution of the Board, in amounts necessary to conduct district activities and services, and to enforce their receipt and collection in the manner prescribed by resolution and authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, the Parrish Fire District may provide for a reasonable schedule of charges for inspecting structures, plans, and equipment to determine compliance with fire safety codes and standards;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District that a User Service Fee Schedule (Exhibit A) is hereby adopted and identified herein as Parrish Fire District User Service Fee Schedule, effective February 1, 2015.

ADOPTED by the Parrish Fire District Board of Fire Commissioners, meeting in regular session on January 27, 2015.
